

COVID-19 EVENT SAFETY GUIDELINES

BEFORE THE EVENT



1. Register on MK JOBS

For the purpose of track and trace ALL VISITORS are required to register their details on the MK Jobs website:

ENTERING THE EVENT

Whilst entering the event there may be a short queue. During this time please maintain a 1m social distance, queuing in the designated area.



1. Bring a copy of your MK JOBS registration email

Please have your MK Jobs registration email ready on your mobile phone or a printed copy to show the organisers, without this you will be unable to enter the MK Job Show.

Your name and the time you enter the MK Job Show will be recorded in the visitor database for the purpose of track and trace.

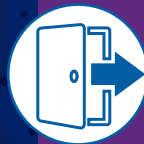


2. Temperature & face mask check

In accordance with government guidelines all visitors are required to wear a face covering, you will need to provide this yourself and wear this at all times. All visitors will be temperature checked before entrance. If you have a temperature of 37.8C or greater you will not be permitted entry into the event.

AT THE EVENT

Whilst attending the event please maintain a 1m social distance from all other visitors, exhibitors and staff at all times.



1. Entrance & Exit

The event will be completely enclosed apart from one Entrance and one Exit. Each time you enter or exit the event please state your name.



2. One-way system & wide aisles

To maintain social distance we have introduced:

- A one-way system for all visitors. Aisles will be clearly marked and easy to follow.
- 3m+ wide aisles to help you maintain social distancing.



3. Exhibitor face shields

All exhibitors will be provided with a face shield to maintain the safety of you and the employer, allowing you to discuss the opportunities they are offering with ease.



4. Hand sanitising stations

Throughout the event space there will be hand sanitising stations for you to use.
